### ASSESSING THE IMPACT OF TECHNOLOGY ON QUALITY IN NURSING HOMES

As long-term care providers are pushed to improve quality, a burning question looms: What role does technology play? University of Missouri Sinclair School of Nursing professor Gregory Alexander, Ph.D., will inform participants about how resident care management, clinical support and integration are the triangle of IT sophistication in nursing homes. Attendees will learn how to look at IT variables and learn about a study examining differences in long-term care based on factors such as region or size. They will be able to come away with an understanding of nursing home quality measures and the role of IT sophistication.
